Dear Taxpayer:

This letter responds to our conversation on Jan. 02, 2018, when you asked about ways to resolve your account balance.

Based on your proposal, we established your installment agreement for \$260.00. Your payment is due on the 28th of each month, beginning on Feb. 28, 2018.

WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW ABOUT YOUR INSTALLMENT AGREEMENT

Your installment agreement includes all balances due that you are liable for. This may include taxes you owe on other accounts where:

- You filed as a secondary taxpayer on another account for a jointly filed return.
- You are an individual and you operate a business as a sole proprietor.
- You requested an installment agreement for your business where you operate as a sole proprietor, but also have tax due for your individual income tax account, Form 1040.

We included in your agreement the tax you owe for taxpayer identification number 356-40-5132 for the tax periods listed below. We will include these amounts in your monthly reminder notices.
