I'm writing to let you know that we've reviewed the accounts and the accounts are in currently not collectable.

What to expect

A yearly notice will be issued by IRS advising of the balances. I'm closing your case with the Taxpayer Advocate Service.

IRS records indicate outstanding balances for tax years 2007, 2008, 2009, 2010 and 2011. The current balances, computed with accrued penalty and interest charges to August 2, 2019, are:
